Directions to the North Star Vacation Club

For further directions or help finding the resort once you are on the road, call the resort at 802-422-5050.

Directions from the Hartford CT Area:

Take Route I-91 North to Exit 6 (Rutland, VT exit). Take a left at the bottom of the exit ramp onto Route 103. Follow the signs for Ludlow; you will go through Chester then through Ludlow. Once you have passed the access road to Okemo Ski Area you will come to the junction of 100 North and Route 103, (approximately one mile). Take a right on Route 100 North. Drive for approximately 15 miles (you will pass Route 100A) until you reach the junction of Route 4. Take a left onto Route 4 heading west and proceed 6 miles until you reach the jct. of Route 100 North (right turn) and the Killington Access Road (left turn). Turn left and go up access road one mile (through traffic light) and take your first left after traffic light. This is the entrance to North Star.

Directions from Northern Vermont:

Two routes of travel are available: **(1)** Route 7 South to Rutland and junction of Route 4 East. Route 4 East approximately 10 miles East to just past the junction of 100 North. Get into right hand lane and take a right up the Killington Access Road approximately one mile (through traffic light) just after light, take your first left into the North Star entrance. **(2)** I-89 South to Exit 3 (Bethel). At bottom of ramp take a right and proceed west on 107 until you reach 100 South. Continue on route 100 South through Pittsfield until you reach the junction of Route 4. Go across Route 4 and up the Killington Access Road. Proceed one mile up access road, through traffic light, and take your first left after light to the entrance road to North Star Lodge.

Directions from the Boston area:

Take I-93 North to just south of Concord NH onto I-89 North. Travel for approximately 45 minutes to Exit 1 in Vermont which is U.S. Route 4 the Woodstock/Rutland exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp, go left onto U.S. Route 4 Heading west. Follow U.S. Route 4 west, approximately 26 to the junction of Route 100 North (on right) and Killington Access Road (on left). You will pass the junction of Route 100A and 100 South. Do not take these routes. Turn left up Killington Access Road and proceed one mile (through traffic light). The entrance to North Star is the first left after the traffic light. This is the entrance to North Star Lodge.

Directions from NY/NJ area:

Take the NY Thruway to Exit 24 in Albany. Take I- 87 (Northway) North to Exit 20, (Fort Ann/Rutland Exit). Pick up NY Route 149 and follow until you pick up U.S. Route 4 heading toward Rutland. Once you reach Rutland, follow signs to continue on Route 4 East. You will be on Route 7 North for a short time. Continue on Route 4 East approximately 10 to 12 miles to just past the 100 North exit. Get into right hand lane and take a right up the Killington Access Road approximately one mile (through traffic light). Just after light, take your first left into the North Star entrance.
